I will work to keep the garden a happy, secure and enjoyable place where all participants can garden and socialize peacefully in a neighborly manner.

I will garden according to organic principles and use no synthetic fertilizers, pesticides or herbicides.

I understand that neither Grow Team ONE nor the Visiting Nurse Association of Chittenden and Grand Isle Counties are responsible for my actions. I therefore agree to hold harmless Grow Team ONE and the Visiting Nurse Association of Chittenden and Grand Isle Counties for any liability, damage, loss or claim that occurs in connection with the use of the site by me or any of my guests.
